The member shall provide the Cooperative at the time of submission of registration a photograph of the pet and retain the photograph in the member's file.

The member acknowledges that by the signing of this registration form that he/she has received and read the Cooperative Service Animal Policy. The member understands that in order to continue to have the privilege of retaining a service animal they must abide by all governmental regulations of domestic animals and comply with the terms of the Cooperative's rules regulating animals as set forth in the Cooperative documents.

In the event the member permits the animal to cause damage to the member's unit and/or permits the animal to cause a health hazard, the Cooperative shall have the right to cause the member to pay for the cost of repair and require the member to remove the animal from the town home. Failure to comply will result in termination of tenancy.

The maximum weight limit for an adult service animal permitted by the Cooperative is 15 pounds or less. The member must show hardship or extraordinary circumstances to exceed the weight limit and gain Board of Director approval. In the event the service animal causes interior damage or creates foul orders in the town home the member is in violation as set forth below. Current breeds not permitted at Yorkshire Plaza - Pit Bulls, Rottweilers, and Dobermans.

You will be provided an identification medallion, which must be with the service animal at all times. The cooperative will also place a sticker on a window in your unit to identify, for Management, that there is an animal in your unit. Failure to display the medallion or remove the sticker is a violation and will subject you to fines and or revocation of approval to maintain a service animal. You will be required on an annual basis to: 1) confirm that you have a service animal, 2) confirm that it is the same approved service animal, and 3) confirm that the City license is still in effect.

In the event the member fails to comply with the City Ordinances the member acknowledges that he/she will be in non-compliance of his/her Occupancy Agreement and the Rules & Regulations. As a result the members may lose the privilege of retaining the service animal; in addition the Cooperative may terminate the membership and commence a termination of tenancy action.
